

Traffic Controller Course Overview



This course provides training for staff who are required to control traffic with a Stop Slow bat. This course will provide participants with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to perform traffic control safely for their co-workers and the public.

Target Audience

Any person who may be required to control traffic using a Stop-Slow bat in the Road Construction and Maintenance Industry.

Learning Outcomes

- Understand the role of a Traffic Controller.
- Apply the procedures of traffic controlling within a worksite.
- Operate a 2-way radio correctly and effectively.
- Promote the role of traffic controller in the community.

Pre-requisites

- Adequate literacy

AND HOLD

- A NSW WorkCover Construction Induction Certificate or equivalent

AND HOLD OR HAVE PREVIOUSLY HELD

- A NSW P2 Drivers Licence *or* equivalent *or* higher

OR HAVE HELD

- A NSW Traffic Controller Photo ID card (expired within the last two years)

Duration

The duration of this course is **one** day

Validity

The Traffic Controllers Photo Identification Card is valid for three (3) years

Class Size

Minimum 5 participants
Maximum 16 participants

Delivery

Classroom including discussion groups and simulated exercises in controlling traffic, including the use of a 2-way radio.

Participants must complete knowledge and skills assessment at the end of the course.
